Artist: Picasso was a Spanish painter famous for his abstract portraits Skill: To be able to fill a given space appropriately and create an asymmetric portrait Vocab: abstract, asymmetrical, portrait, cubism	Artist: Hans Coper was a German ceramic artist famous for his abstract pottery Skill: To be able to form a pinch pot and use tools to etch designs into clay Vocab: ceramic, pottery, slip, etch

Abstract: things that do not exist and are thought up in the mind,



Asymmetrical: not the same arrangement on the other side.
