<p>Artist: Wassily Kandinsky was a Russian artist who used shapes, lines and bright colours to produce his paintings.</p> <p>Skill: To be able to use a pencil, ruler and shape templates to draw a range of shapes and patterns</p> <p>Vocab: artist, pattern, shape, line, space, primary colours</p>	<p>Artist: Andy Goldsworthy is a British sculptor who uses natural materials to create sculptures.</p> <p>Skill: To be able to select a range of natural resources to create a pattern within sculpture</p> <p>Vocab: sculptor, natural, repeating pattern, symmetry, sculpture</p>

<p>Artist: Vincent Van Gogh was a Dutch painter who painted the sunflower and starry night.</p> <p>Skill: To be able to create texture with oil pastel and blend colours</p> <p>Vocab: Still life, texture, blending, landscape, portrait</p>	<p>Artist: Hannah Hoch was a German artist who collaged pictures and photographs to create her artwork.</p> <p>Skill: To be able to use scissors accurately and collect and arrange images in an appealing way</p> <p>Vocab: Collage, background, foreground</p>

Henry Matisse - end points	Giorgio Morandi - end points
Artist: Henri Matisse was a French sculptor, painter and printmaker famous for his brightly coloured collages and prints Skill: To be able to create a collage of shapes in a range of colours which are positioned in an appealing way Vocab: print maker, contrast/ contrasting colours, secondary colours, overlap, position)	Artist: Giorgio Morandi was an Italian painter famous for his muted still life paintings of ceramics Skill: observational drawing and shading to create the effect of 3D objects on paper. Vocab: muted colours, observe, gradient, shadow, blur, highlight

Artist: Picasso was a Spanish painter famous for his abstract portraits Skill: To be able to fill a given space appropriately and create an asymmetric portrait Vocab: abstract, asymmetrical, portrait, cubism	Artist: Hans Coper was a German ceramic artist famous for his abstract pottery Skill: To be able to form a pinch pot and use tools to etch designs into clay Vocab: ceramic, pottery, slip, etch

<p>Artist: Georgia O'Keffe was an American artist best known for her paintings of natural landscapes and flowers</p> <p>Skill: To be able to use watercolour to blend colours</p> <p>Vocab: intricate, vibrant, water colour, brushstrokes</p>	<p>Artist: Beatriz Milhazes is a Brazilian artist known for her colourful imagery inspired by Brazilian culture</p> <p>Skill: To be able to overlap intricately cut shapes and position in an appealing way.</p> <p>Vocab: contemporary, imagery, geometric</p>

<p>Artist: Ls Lowry is a Salford born artist who is best known for his urban landscapes with matchstick men.</p> <p>Skill: to use perspective to create an effective drawing.</p> <p>Vocab: urban, cityscape, industrial, perspective, proportion</p>	<p>Artist: Antoni Gaudi was a Spanish/Catalan architect famous for his unique buildings in Barcelona including Sagrada Familia.</p> <p>Skills: To be able to strengthen a structure with paper mache and modrock</p> <p>Vocab: architect, modernism, modrock, structure, paper mache, strengthen</p>
