**Uniform Policy** 

#### **Our Vision**

Our school vision is for all pupils to flourish academically, spiritually and socially.

Wearing the correct uniform helps children to flourish academically, by preventing distractions caused by fashion trends.

Wearing a uniform helps children to flourish spiritually and socially, because it fosters a sense of community and equality among pupils.

#### Affordability

We have made every effort to ensure that our school uniform is affordable for parents and carers. To keep costs down, there are only two items of clothing – sweatshirts and cardigans – that include the school logo, though the logo is not compulsory.

### **Everyday Uniform**

- Black trousers or shorts
- Black pinafore or black skirt (skirts should be knee-length or longer to ensure they are appropriate for school. We kindly ask that shorter skirts are not worn)
- Blue and white summer dress (optional in warmer months)
- White polo shirt (no logo)
- Black shoes (no trainers, platform soles, or high heels)
- Black tights or white socks for girls
- Black socks for boys
- · Navy blue sweatshirt (school logo optional)
- Navy blue cardigan (school logo optional)
- Navy blue book bag (school logo optional)

## **PE Kit**

Children must wear their PE kit to school on PE days.

- Plain white t-shirt
- Plain black sweatshirt
- Plain black shorts, leggings, or jogging bottoms
- Plain black PE pumps/trainers

## **Footwear**

- Sensible black shoes.
- No platform soles, high heels, or trainers (as these are considered unsuitable for daily school wear).

#### **Jewellery/Watches**

For safety reasons:

- Jewellery is not permitted, except for small stud earrings.
- Earrings must be removed for PE and swimming lessons.

Watches – to be analogue or digital. No Smart Watches. Fitbits may be worn.

#### Makeup/nails

Make-up, false nails and false eyelashes are not permitted.

Nail varnish is not permitted.

## The importance of naming uniform items

All uniform items must be clearly named, including coats, as we do not have space to store lost property.

#### **Non-uniform days**

Occasionally, we have non-uniform days, for example when we ask for donations for our summer fair. On non-uniform days, the following rules apply:

- Practical shoes/trainers only (no high heels or heelys)
- Shorts or bicycle shorts are allowed as long as they are just above the knee or lower (very short skirts or shorts are not allowed)
