Artist: Vincent Van Gogh was a Dutch painter who painted the sunflower and starry night. Skill: To be able to create texture with oil pastel and blend colours Vocab: Still life, texture, blending, landscape, portrait	Artist: Hannah Hoch was a German artist who collaged pictures and photographs to create her artwork. Skill: To be able to use scissors accurately and collect and arrange images in an appealing way Vocab: Collage, background, foreground

Still life: objects used for drawing or painting Texture: the look or feel of a surface



Blending: mixing something together to it is not separate



Landscape: a picture that shows the view of an area



Portrait: a painting, drawing or sculpture of a person.



Collage: a type of artwork where materials are pasted together.



Background: a part of a picture that is the furthest away.



Foreground: a part of a picture that is the nearest to you.
